Submissions

We welcome submissions (6-8 pages, Springer LNCS format) solely authored by doctoral students describing their current research. Acknowledgements to the supervisor can be included. The paper must include:

- Introduction and Motivation, identifying a significant problem in the field and its importance,
- Clear formulation of research question(s),
- State of the Art - describing related work or studies,
- Research Method, i.e., research methodology that is applied or planned,
- Results and their evaluation/validation,
- Conclusions.

The extended version may be co-authored.
